The Ottawa chapter saw an increase of 191 hostings in 2021 for a total of 596 cumulative hostings. One of the many inspiring stories is that of a young mom who left human trafficking. She was referred by a social service agency that provides support for women and girls involved in the Canadian justice



Mom was pregnant and needed someone to look after her young toddler while she went into the hospital. She was matched with a Host Family who became the loving extended family this young mom could trust and rely on. They have been there for her and her children throughout all of the ups and downs in 2021 and remain committed to providing ongoing care, love and compassionate support for her children as needed.


